INVITATION

On behalf of the Danish Geotechnical Society it is a pleasure to invite you to attend the Nordic Geotechnical Meeting (NGM) in Copenhagen 9th – 12th of May 2012. This conference will be the 16th NGM, where the last was held in Sandefjord in Norway, 2008.

The aim of the conference is to strengthen the relationships between practicing engineers, researchers, and scientists in the Nordic region within the fields of geotechnics and engineering geology. All are invited to share their experience and knowledge with their Nordic colleagues. The conference is held at Tivoli Congress Center in the centre of Copenhagen, Denmark. We welcome accompanying persons to the conference, a separate day programme will not be present but information on activities in Copenhagen will be available.

THE SCIENTIFIC PROGRAMME

The conference will include invited lectures and presentation of submitted papers, divided in themed sessions. All papers submitted will have the possibility of being presented in a session.

Articles are preferred in English but Nordic languages are accepted (Norwegian, Swedish and Danish).

ABSTRACTS, PAPERS AND PROCEEDINGS

We invite you to submit an abstract(s), no more than 300 words for review. Abstracts must be submitted online before May 30th, 2011. A link to online submission is provided on www.ngm2012.dk.

The abstracts will be reviewed and authors informed of acceptance by September 2nd, 2011. All accepted abstracts will be published on the homepage www.ngm2012.dk. The deadline for submission of paper is set to December 5th, 2011. The papers will be reviewed, and if any corrections are needed the deadline for the final paper is February 20th 2012.

Articles are preferred in English but Nordic languages are accepted (Norwegian, Swedish and Danish).

All presentations, including powerpoint and speech, must be in English.

All accepted papers will be published in the Conference Proceedings and handed out at the registration desk. The papers will in addition be available on an electronic media.

MAIN THEMES FOR THE CONFERENCE

The following presents main themes for the conference. Papers can relate to projects on land, nearshore as well as offshore structures.

1. Site investigations and laboratory testing
2. Design parameters and modelling
3. Shallow and deep foundations
4. Deep excavations and retaining structures
5. Tunnelling and underground structures
6. Slope stability and landslides
7. Infrastructure projects
8. Ground improvement
9. Environmental geotechnics

The themes will be organized in sessions.
